Franz Bourlet

- * Current status of Open Source and Linux on IBM Power Systems and IBM I What about the new languages on Power Systems : GIT, Orion, Python and to get started with -

Franz is a Client Technical Sales Specialist for IBM POWER Systems in Belgium. He holds a master degree in German philology and one in business management. He joined IBM in 1988 and immediately specialized in POWER systems (then called AS/400), in various roles. After an experience in storage solutions, Franz came back to his roots in 2013, this time with a stronger focus on Linux and open source solutions on POWER.

Franz has over 20 years of practical experience with Linux and open source, on POWER, x86 and ARM architectures. He is both a Certified Linux Administrator and a certified POWER specialist.

Session abstract:

Once a "me too" model, open source has now become the main source of innovation in the IT world. Every hype of the moment (cloud, noSQL databases, big data, cognitive, HPC, Blockchain,...) is led by open source solutions that pervade everywhere, from small businesses to large corporations. IBM i has been an early adopter of open source technologies (think of PHP, Apache and MySQL) but the last two years have seen a dramatic acceleration of this adoption, with the arrival of multiple open source tools and solutions on our favorite OS.

In this session, Franz will explain how POWER has become the most open server architecture in the industry, and how new open source tools like Ruby, Node.JS and others have been integrated into IBM i, RPG and DB2 to deliver the next generation of business applications.

Fabian is an Expert Level Certified Consulting IT Specialist. He is acting as a Client Technical Architect for IBM Systems in Belgium. Session abstract:

Fabian will cover the recent Power Systems and IBM i announcements from February 2017. With the IBM i 7.3 Technology Refresh 2, announced on February 14, IBM introduced four key enhancements:

- A new model of the IBM Power System S812 designed for smaller organizations that do not need system virtualization.
- An Enhanced JSON environment and new built-in functions to improve ease-of-use for SQL programmers.
- A new Open Source portfolio expansion including a "zero-configuration" database and new tools such as wget, curl, rsync and sqlite.
- And last but not least, lots of IBM i Access Client Solutions new functions like filtering of spool files, SQL Scripts and CL prompter to improve flexibility and speed of development.
